Swim Saskatchewan will now be adopting the Swimming Canada officials attire, as taught and illustrated into Introduction to Swimming Officiating course. This will be told to all those taking the Introduction to Officiating Course at the Mass Clinic tomorrow in Moose Jaw.

Therefore, this is a request for clubs to send out via email, post on their club website, put in newsletter etc. that all officials working at any type of swim meet (timed finals, heats and finals, development, age group, summer, winter, masters etc.) in Saskatchewan are to wear the following:

Timers and Chief Timers – White T Shirt, Black bottoms and black shoes

All other officials – Red Polo, Black bottoms and black shoes

In the coming months Swim Sask will endeavor to work with a supplier in Regina for Red Officials shirts with the Swim Sask Logo on it.
